

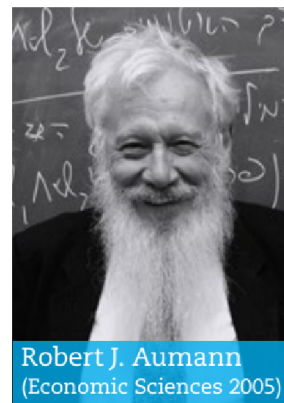
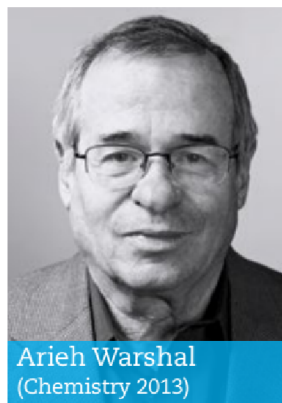
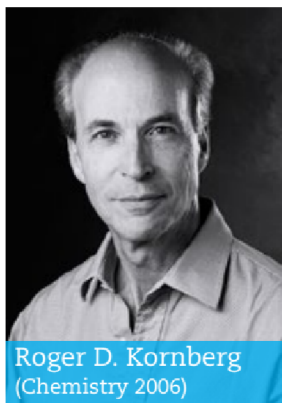
We are delighted to announce the re-launching of the WSCI -World Science Conference – Israel - 2015, to be held in Jerusalem, Israel, on August 15-20.

Initiated by Nobel Laureate Prof. Roger Kornberg (USA), in collaboration with the Hebrew University, the Ministry of Science and the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the state of Israel, The WSCI will bring brilliant students from all around the world for an exciting five day program. During the conference the participants will have a chance to attend lectures, interact and to be inspired by Nobel Laureates, Wolf Prize winners, Fields Medal winners as well as other leading scientists from around the world.

The students will also experience a unique opportunity to meet and get to know 300 bright students from five continents, among them, probably included the next generation leading scientists.

Modeled after the Lindau Science Meeting which has been held in Germany for more than half a century, and the decade old Asian Science Camp (ASC) the WSCI will provide a unique platform for inspiration, dialogue and discussion between promising young talents and attending Nobel Laureates and Eminent Scientists. It will also help to develop international friendships and cooperation among students from all over the world and focuses on excellent 17-21 years old students.

The WSCI will take place on August 15-20, 2015 at the Edmond J. Safra campus of the Hebrew University, Jerusalem, Israel. Among the lecturers are the following Nobel Laureates:



Additional Nobel Laureates, Wolf Prize Winners & Eminent Scientists will be updated on our website.

We would like to invite 3 students along with one accompanying person from Vietnam as delegates to WSCI-2015. WSCI participants need to have keen interest and be outstanding in Natural Sciences and Mathematics, from High School (12th grade) or University (undergraduate students) – age 17 to 21 years. The students should be proficient both spoken and written English, as the entire program will be conducted in English.

Please re-confirm your intention to send the delegation by April 1st. A list of the delegates and the accompanying person by April 16th will be highly appreciated.

WSCI organizers will cover the full board accommodation throughout the conference days for the participants and the adult delegation head. Transportation from and to the airport will be provided.

No registration or tuition fees apply. Airfare, travel insurance and possible extra days stay in Israel, will not be funded by the organizers.

We do hope that students from Vietnam will participate in WSCI-2015. We greatly appreciate your assistance and thank you for your cooperation in advance. Kindly acknowledge receipt of this letter.
